FAIR data help to share information in my project

How?

- Make agreements on how research data are managed and shared between research partners.
- Establish clear guidelines on how to document data in a consistent form, e.g. as templates for tables or notebooks.
- Use a secure shared storage system with controlled access management for all data.

Why?

- You avoid misunderstandings regarding access to and use of the data.
- You foster collaboration to make best use of the data, speed up the processes and reduce administration.
- You improve the quality of the data and thus the scientific output from the project.

FAIR data are: **F**indable, **A**ccessible, **I**nteroperable and **R**eusable.

Making your data FAIR means maximizing the project's output, increasing your impact and enhancing your recognition as a researcher.
